COIN TOSS

Before we start the Main Auction lets have some fun!!

Take out your **\$1** bills and stand up. Someone will be coming around to collect and while they're doing that you decide if you want to call "heads" or "tails". The referee will yell "HANDS UP IF YOU THINK IT WILL BE HEADS, HANDS DOWN IF YOU THINK IT WILL BE TAILS.

The referee will flip a coin. If you guessed incorrectly you sit down. If you guessed correctly you stay standing. You continue choosing "heads or tails" until you guess wrong and we continue the process until only one person is left standing. The winner receives a gift certificate.

Silent & Oral Auction Rules

Each person will be assigned a bid number. This bid number will be used for the Silent & Oral Auctions.

For the silent auction with each item is a bid sheet. Persons wishing to bid must do so by writing their number and bid on the sheet. **Each new bid must increase the previous bid by \$1.00; otherwise the bid is void.** All items on the silent auction may be bid on during the main (oral) auction until the sections close. The Light Blue Section will close at 8:15p.m. The Navy Section will close at 8:45p.m. The auctioneer will announce their closing times, along with ringing of the bell.

The last bid number with the highest bid to appear on the bid sheet will be the purchaser. Payment must be made in full tonight by cash or check. Make checks payable to St. Mary's Church, Silent & Oral Auction receipts may be combined.

When payment has been made at the cashier's table, bidders should take the receipt to one of the auction committee members to claim their items at the table where they are displayed. **Do not pick up items before payment!!** All gift certificates, ball game tickets and certificates for service can be claimed at the cashier's table. If all merchandise can be removed this evening, that is preferred. A committee member will be at the gym Sunday morning from 9-11a.m. Use the gym door on the church side to enter.

Please note: Expiration dates or specific conditions for services or gift certificates can be found on the certificates placed on the tables next to their corresponding bid sheets.
